JCAHO issues proposed new patient safety goals for 2007

The Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations is accepting comments from the field through Jan. 8 on five new (http://www.jcaho.org/accredited+organizations/hospitals/standards/field+reviews/07_npsg_cah_hap_fr.htm) patient safety goals proposed for JCAHO-accredited hospitals in 2007. A proposed new goal calling for hospitals to identify safety risks inherent in their patient population recasts two patient safety goals for 2006 as requirements under the new goal. Another new goal targets improved recognition and response to changes in patients' conditions. Other proposed goals call for hospitals to discourage disruptive staff behavior such as condescending language or refusal to answer questions, which can decrease morale and have a negative effect on patient safety; provide orientation to temporary or agency workers to minimize the potential for errors; and implement processes to identify health care worker fatigue that poses a threat to patient safety. A proposed new requirement for the existing goal to improve the safety of using medications calls for reducing the likelihood of patient harm associated with the use of anticoagulation therapy.
